

ZTA Release Notes 24th November, 2022

This document serves as the release notes for the Instasafe Zero Trust Access (ZTA) platform slated for a rollout on 24th November, 2022. The document contains information about improvements and upgrades made to the Web Portal, which include Feature Enhancements, Bugs resolved, etc. In case of discrepancies between the information provided in the Release Notes and the Product Documentation, the information in the Release Notes is to be assumed to be correct.

* The latest ZTNA 4.16.15.0 is supported only with Network Gateway 4.5.13 or higher. Before rolling out ZTNA 4.16.15.0, please ensure that Network Gateway is upgraded to version 4.5.13 or higher.

Major Bug Fixes

Sr. No.	Description
1	Intermittent disconnection of Always ON applications is addressed.
2	Issue with Always ON when a user logs out of the agent but keeps it open has been addressed.
3	Minor UI fixes in the screen for adding applications.
4	Minor UI fixes in the screen for adding Identity Provider.
5	Auto refresh of User Groups count in the Users tab.
6	Issue with Azure AD user groups getting duplicated has been addressed.
7	Pagination issue with display of user/user groups in access policies has been addressed.
8	Other minor issues in the console addressed.

Known Product Issues

1. If users have the ZTAA agent open when a new network application is added to the Access policy, then users will need to restart the agent for the application to show online in the agent. Until the agent is restarted, the newly added network application will be accessible from the network gateways but will show Offline/Grey in the agent.
2. Network applications will show unstable and will not be accessible when a user logs into the ZTAA agent from a Windows 8.1 Pro 32 bit or 64 bit machine. Network applications will be accessible only after clicking on the Refresh button in the agent.
3. MAC users who are on the production ZTNA version 4.13.0.0 will not get upgraded to the latest ZTNA version automatically. A system restart will need to be done for the latest ZTNA version to be upgraded.
